Venue: Community Area

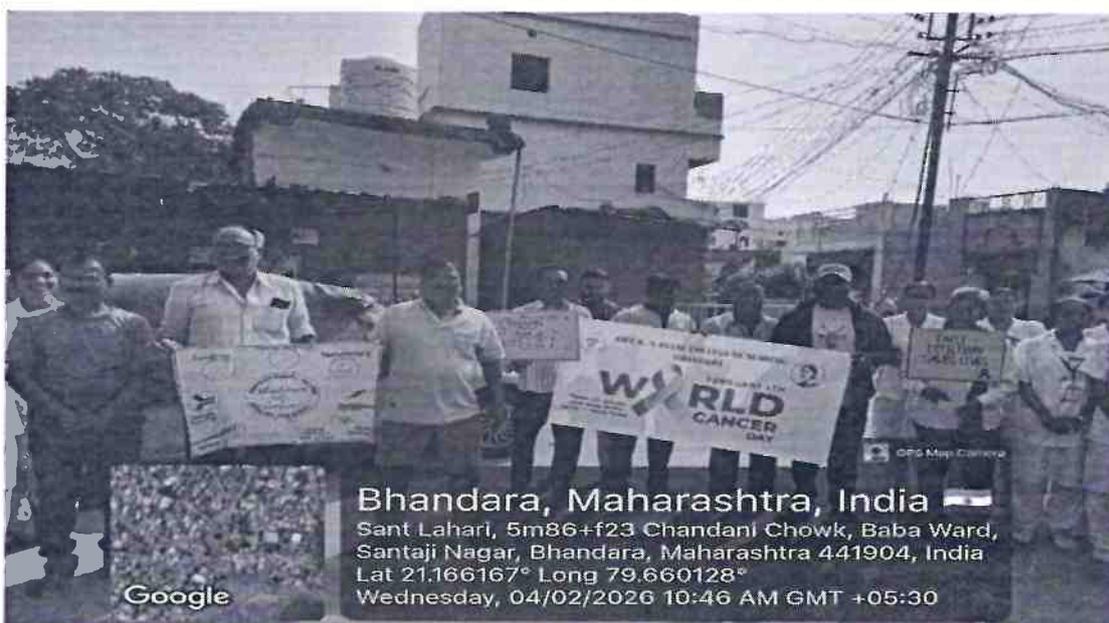
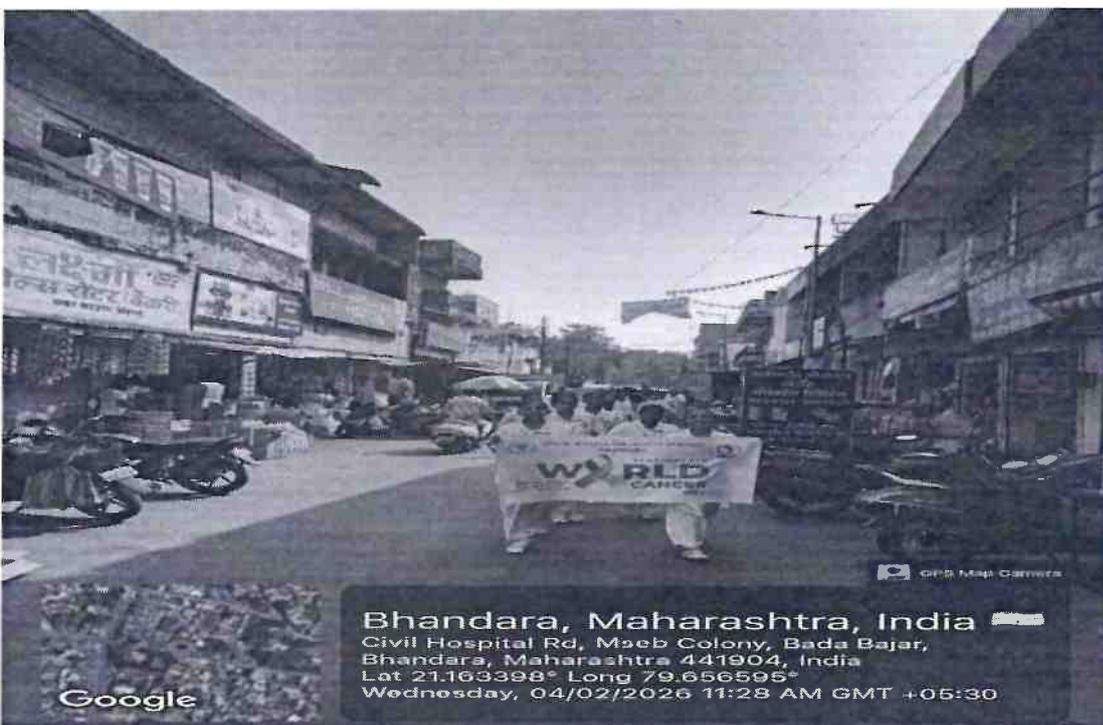
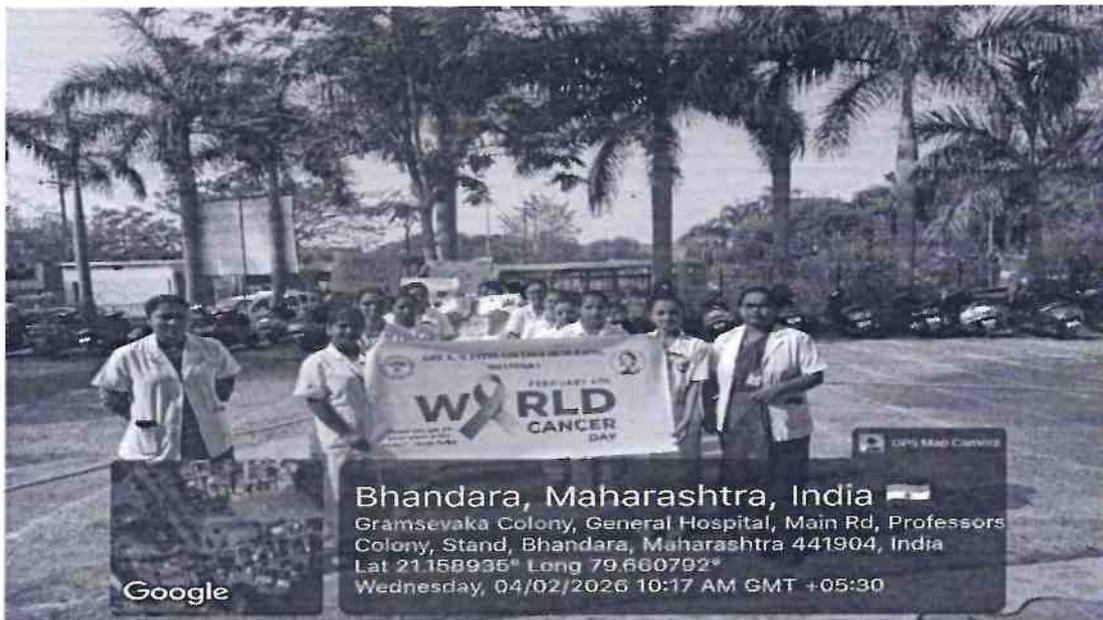

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Report on Lamp Lighting Ceremony

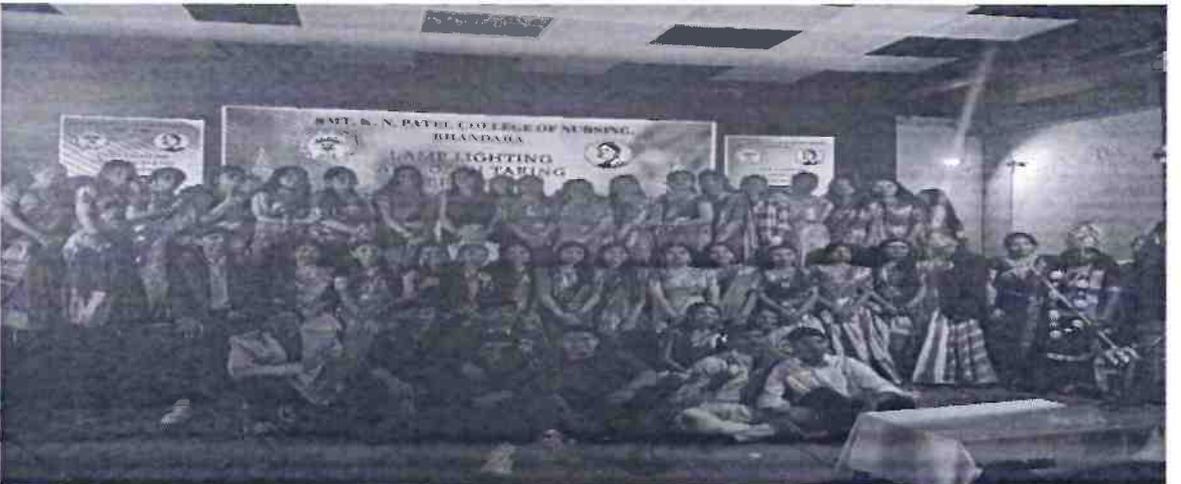
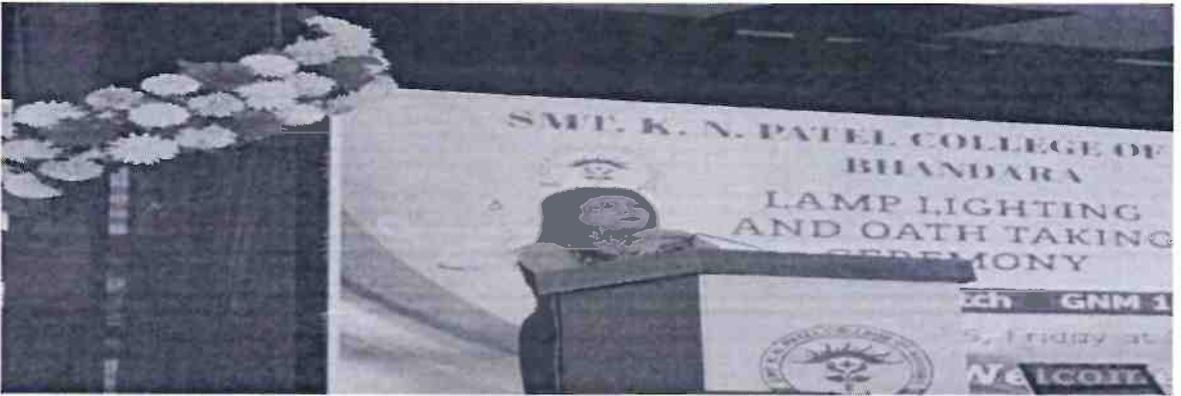

The program began with a welcome speech and introduction to the theme of World AIDS Day – “Ending the HIV epidemic.

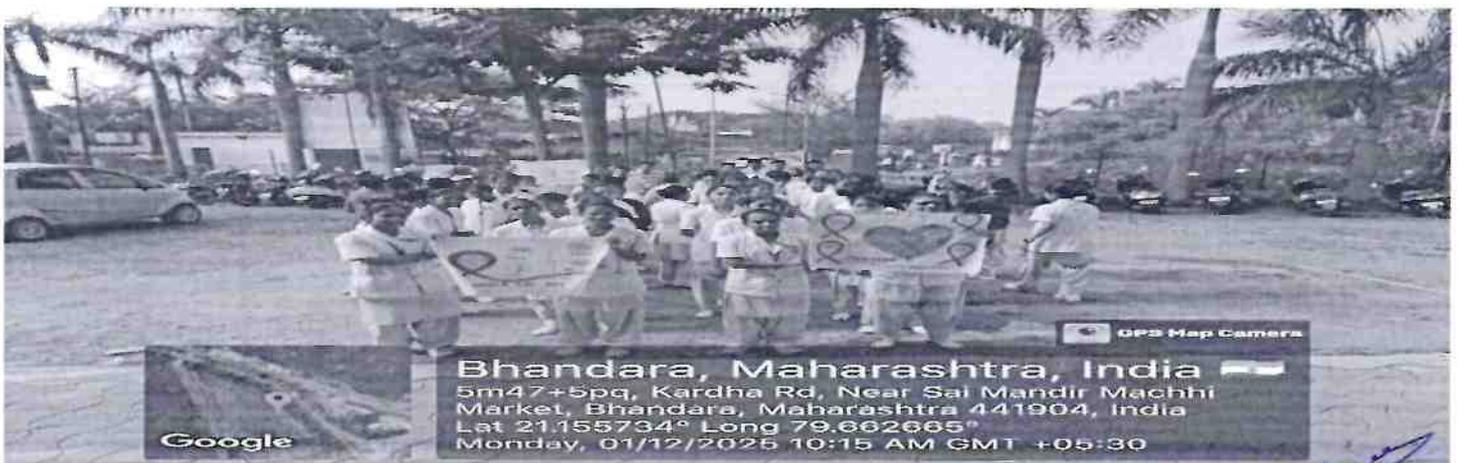
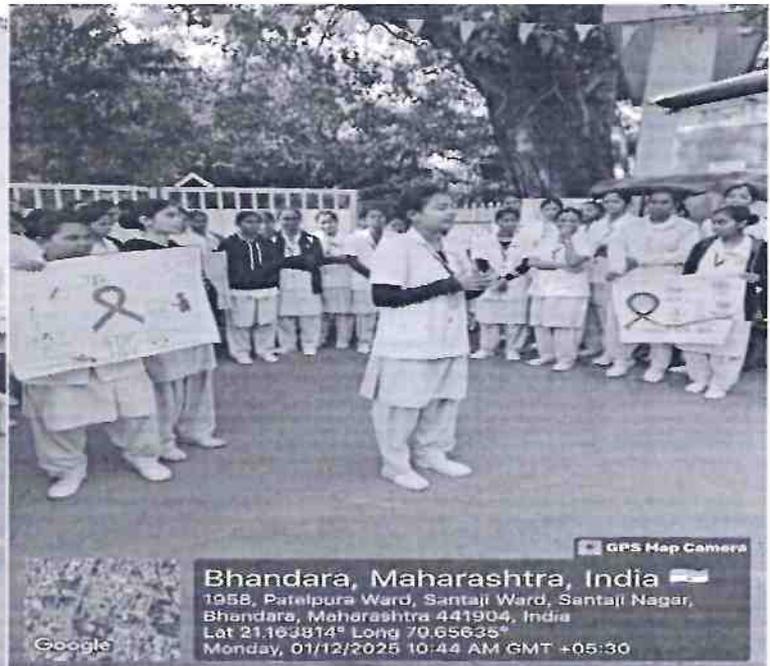
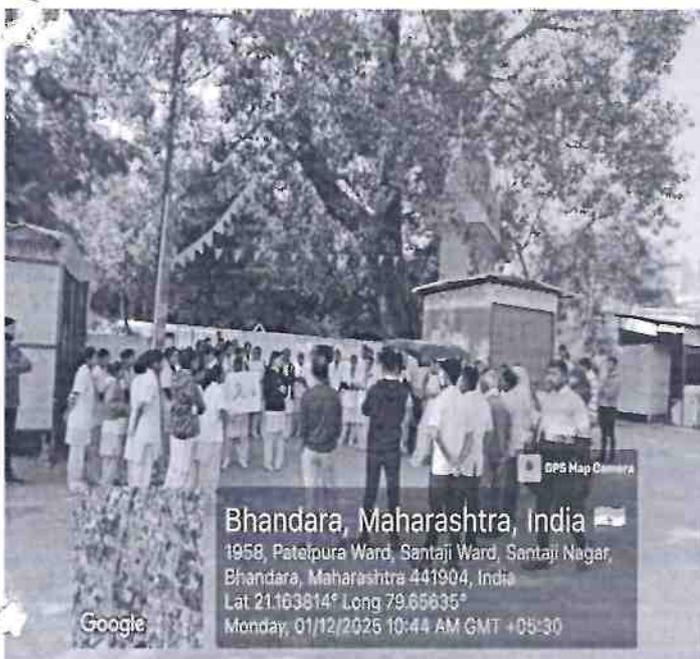
Posters, charts, and models were displayed to make learning more effective. Short video clips were shown to enhance understanding.

Date : 29 September 2025

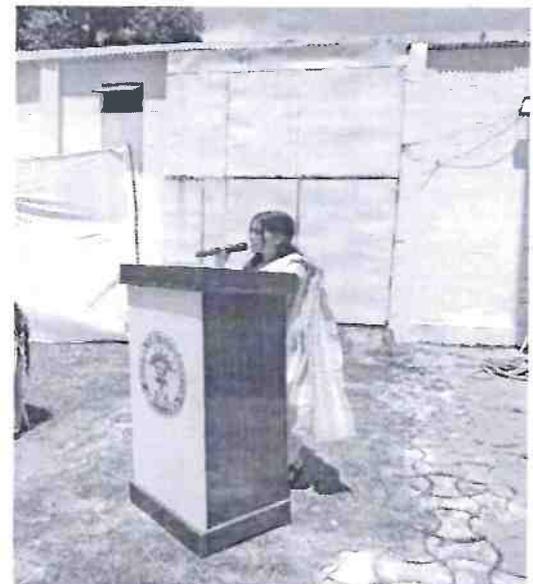
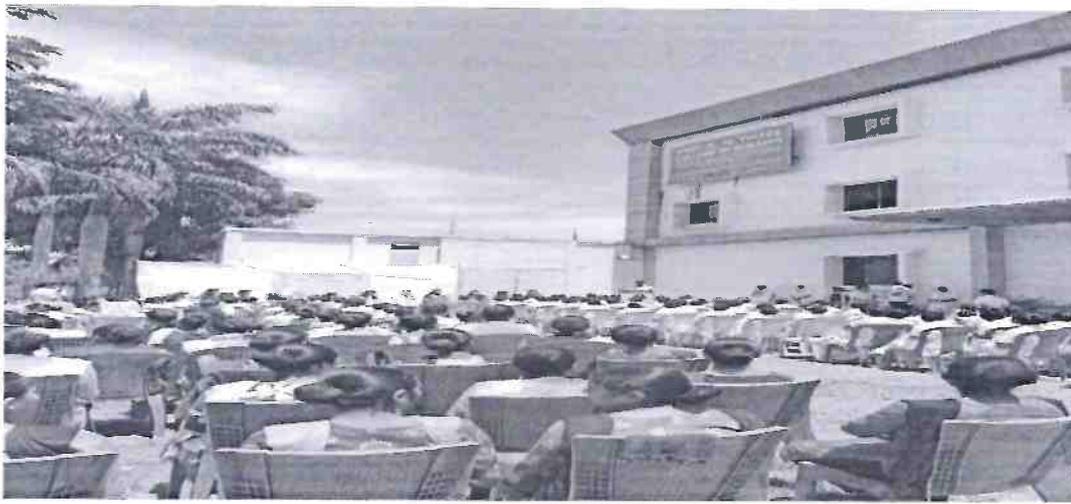

Organized by- K.N. Patel college of nursing, Bhandara

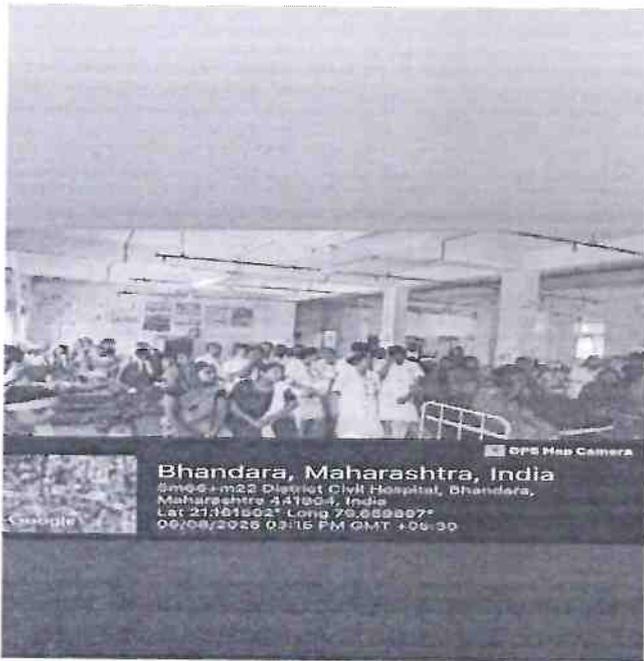
Today on dated 06/08/2025 in Government hospital Bhandara ,we celebrated breastfeeding day celebration by BSC nursing third semester students.

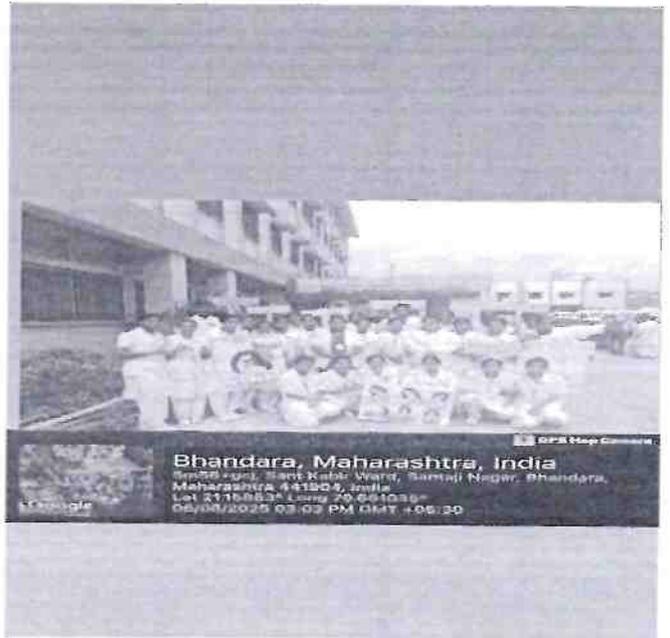

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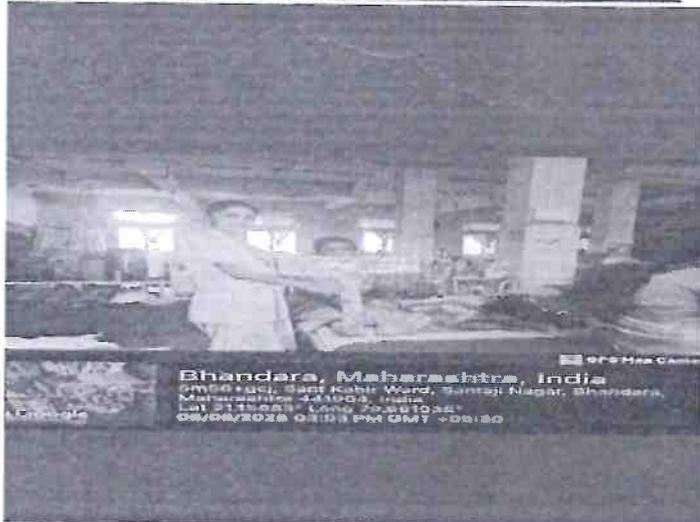
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REPORT ON NUTRITION DAY CELEBRATION

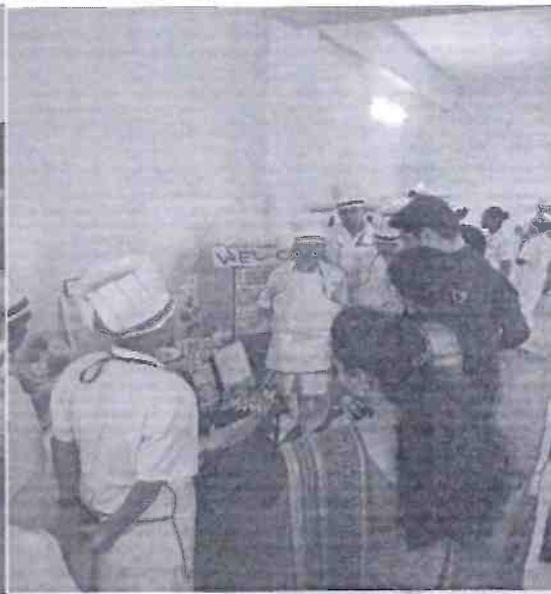

Today on date 13/05/2025 in SMT. K. N. Patel college of Nursing Bhandara, we celebrated International Nurses day.

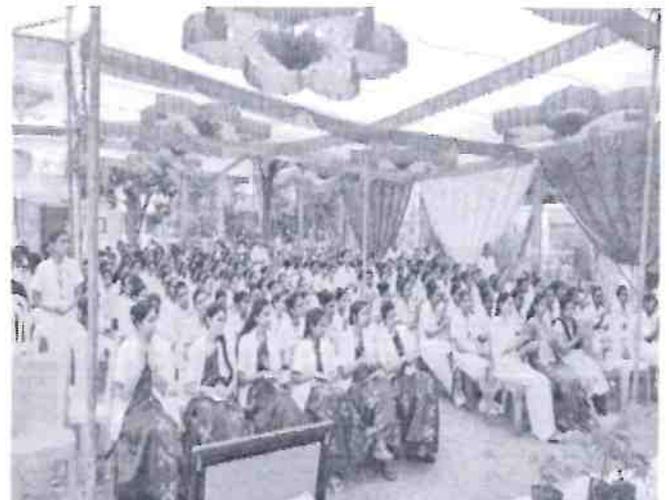
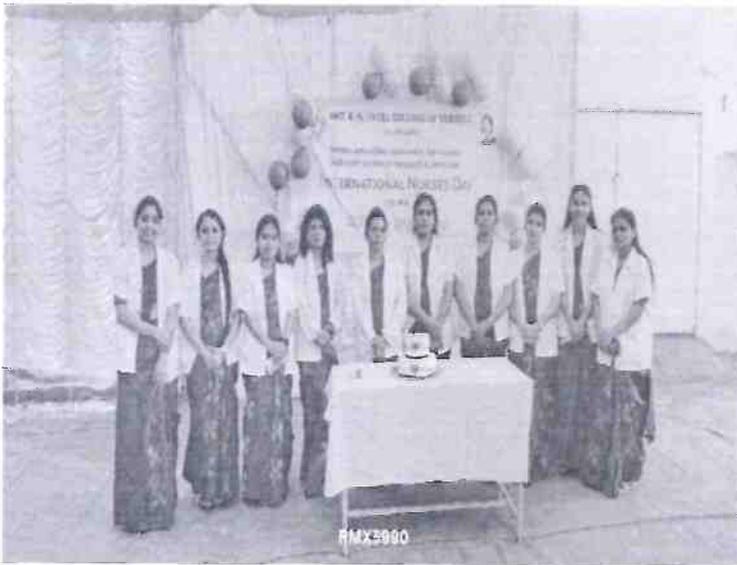
